STUDENT BEHAVIOR CONTRACT

Extended field trips such as the one listed above involve certain possible risks, which make cooperation, responsibility, and self-discipline mandatory. This trip is a privilege.

Students will be considered in school while attending an activity associated with this trip, as well as while traveling and participating in activities during this trip. All school rules will apply during the dates of this trip, and students will be expected to conduct themselves accordingly.

Students possessing or using liquor or tobacco or unlawful drugs will be barred from further participation in the field trip and parents/guardians will be notified immediately to arrange transportation home.

Students must adhere to all room curfews. No one may leave his/her room after this curfew. No one may leave the designated activity area without a Chaperone.

Students will not be allowed to enter each other's room. Boys will not be allowed in any of the girls' rooms, and girls will not be allowed in any of the boys' rooms. This rule is to be abided by at all times. This rule is inclusive of bathrooms, locker rooms, pool rooms, and sauna rooms. There are **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Students will be prompt for all itinerary events. Remember, we travel as a group; therefore, one person's lateness can cause the delay of the entire group.

Students agree that there will be no use of the phones unless calling collect or using a phone card, or if the student has his/her own cell phone. The Student is responsible for his/her own cell phone.

Students agree that there will be no ordering of movies, videos, or video games to their rooms or to any other room. Students also agree that the volume of the television will be kept at a low level so as not to interfere with the rights of other guests in the hotel.

Students agree that no student will answer their room door unless appropriately attired.

Students agree that there will be absolutely no ordering from room service.

Behavior that would interfere with the rights of others, particularly other guests, or that would reflect badly on the Immaculate Conception School, and its Organizers/Chaperones will not be tolerated. This type of behavior includes such things as disrespect, profanity or boisterousness.

Students agree that they will keep their voices down when in common areas such as lobby, hallways, and pool area so as not to interfere with other guests of the hotel. Students also agree to be careful, courteous and respectful.

Any behavior that violates rules established by the Organizers/Chaperones in charge of this trip may result in your being sent home as soon as transportation is arranged. It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to arrange such transportation with reasonable speed.
