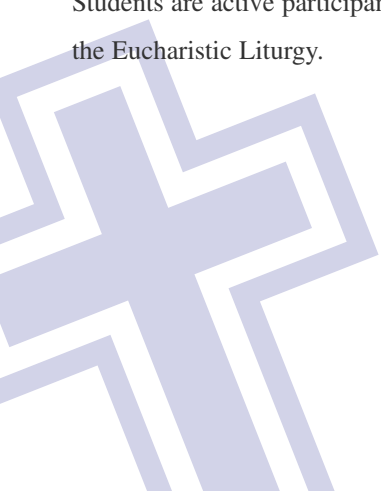




Social Justice, the bringing of Biblical and Gospel values into the society in which we live, is an important part of our school life. Our children have worked on various projects within the community:
