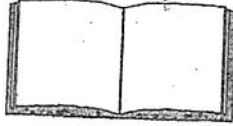


SUMMER READING

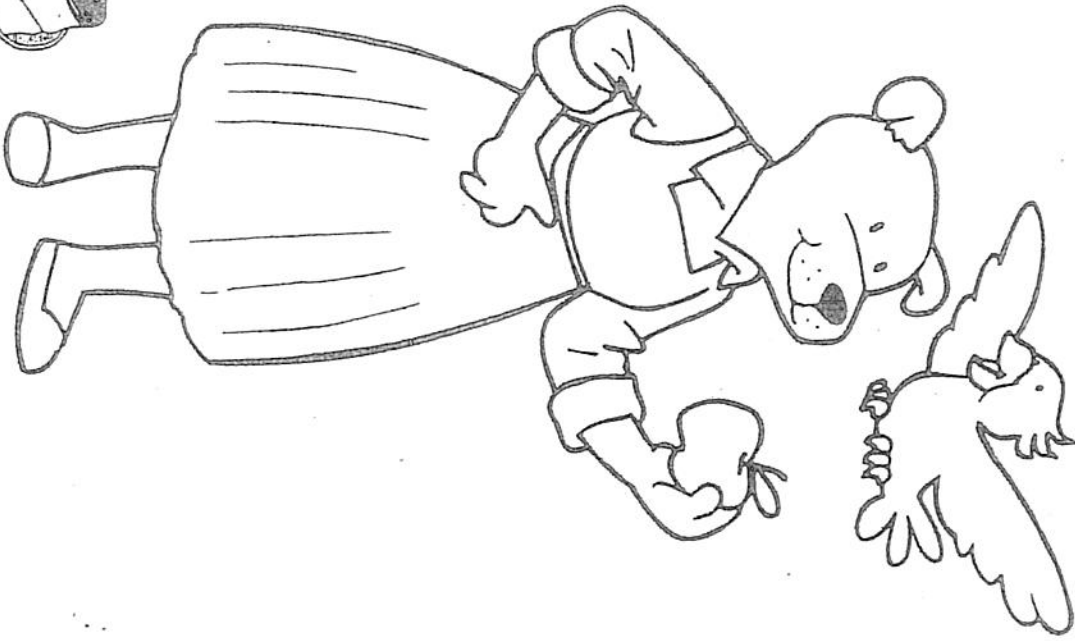
